The Universal Trading Platform will be the new unified trading platform which will give NYSE Euronext's customers access to the group's cash and derivatives markets.

Commenting on connectivity to UTP, Emmanuel Carjat, CEO of Atrium Network said, "By the end of this year, clients will have a huge choice of venues of where to execute their European equities orders with established exchanges and new entrants alike introducing ever more advanced technology.
